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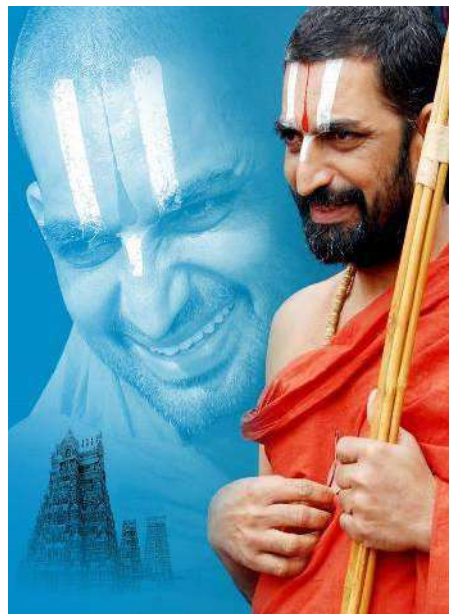

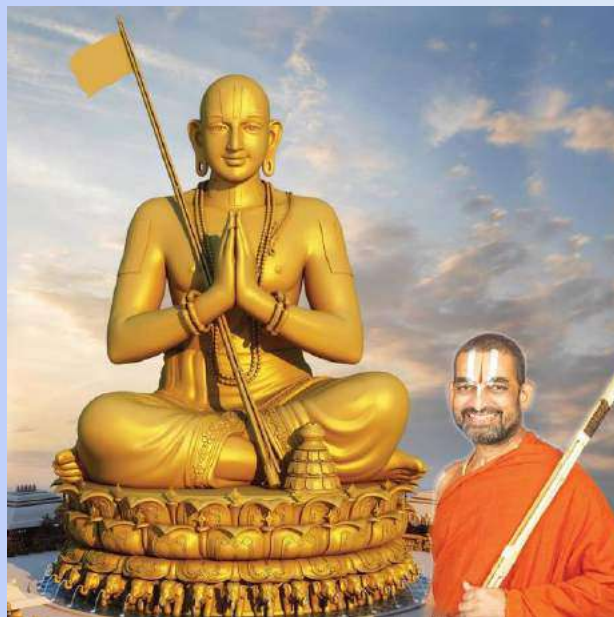

Sri Ra:ma:nuja:charya born in 1017 AD was a great activist and a leader who lead a great EQUALITY MOVEMENT for the first time ever in the annals of history. He was a torchbearer whose principles guide many a leader even today.

The great Swami Vivekananda, Dr. Ambedkar of yesteryear drew their inspiration from this great personality Sri Ra:ma:nujacharya.

Ra:ma:nuja statue weighing 1600 metric tons. The statue will be installed on Bhadravedi, an extra-ordinary stage. Also, consecrating gold deity of Ra:ma:nuja Swamy weighing 120 kgs for daily worship. A unique musical fountain to shower gratitude to Ra:ma:nujacharya through water droplets every evening in a pleasant colorful style. An exciting ride to depict inspiring historic incidents from life of Ra:ma:nujacharya and Construction of models of 108 Divya Desams around the center.

[Project Location](#) Located in the scenic Muchintal Sriramnagar village, Divya Saketham is around 40kms from Hyderabad. It lies amidst about 100 acres of JIVA Campus which houses the Vedic school, Homeopathy Medical College, JIM's hospital, Swamiji's Asramam, a Goshala that houses 300 cows and calves, beautiful gardens and temples. Statue of Equality – 2017 Construction updates

Jan 1st 2017 the first part of the monument has arrived in five containers containing 32 elephants and 18 petals of the lotus.

Jan 8th 2017 2 consignments (consisting of 15 trailers) have been unloaded at the JIVA asramam site.



Jan 9th 2017, Work on the inner structure of the Bhadravedi started. In the inner area, there will be 39 columns out of which first and second column were erected.



Feb 1st 2017, HH Swamiji inspected Statue of Equality construction site and interacted with site engineers and workers and enquired on progress and developments. The team is working on the fabrication and 750 tons of steel has been purchased. The structure began with 39 columns and fabrication has begun on 4-5 levels. Sand blasting, painting of

primer, middle coat and final coat 39 color scheme were done and second level has around 22 columns, above that 15 meters to 22 meters installation is underway. Installation and erection of 22 columns has been completed.

Apr 1st 2017, HH Chinna Jeeyar Swamiji Inspected Statue of Equality Project Site - Total 36 elephants, columns and the lotus flowers parts are being assembled by the 40 member Chinese team. The statue erection and structural erection are together progressing in parallel.



Statue of Equality – 2017

Construction updates

HH inspected the assembly yard where the parts related to Padmapeettam, elephants and lotuses are being assembled. He inspected and inquired about the assembly procedures and discussed details like welding quality, joint quality and inspection procedures with the team.

HH Swamiji also visited the project site where the stone work is being conducted and the site where the statue parts are being assembled. He inquired on the well-being of the team members and also examined the health and safety procedures being followed and implemented. HH Swamiji met and interacted with the Chinese Project Manager and inquired about the health & safety precaution procedures required during welding and grinding.

HH Swamiji visited the various project sites, interacting with the all team members inquiring on their well-being and offered His Mangalasanams.



Jun 13th 2017

- ✔ Installation of the Lotus base at the seventh level has been completed.
- ✔ Welding, grinding and repairing of lotus petals on 4th, 5th and 6th levels is underway.
- ✔ In the Bhadravadi Temple complex, 1100 sq. mts. stone work has been completed.
- ✔ 50 truckloads of stone

material has arrived the site so far and workers are working diligently to complete the Bhadravadi structure on time.

Jun 16th 2017, First Discussion on Lighting Design Begins – Welcoming Mr. Kevin, Our Lighting Design Consultant!



Mr. Kelvin, Our lighting design consultant visited the site to get started on the task to provide initial design for lighting.

- Thridandam (flag pole) has reached the site.
- 4000 square meters of Bhadravadi Temple Complex construction completed.

Sept 2017, 2000 sq. meters out of 17,500 sq. meters of Bhadravadi Temple complex completed.



- ✓ The 'Thridandam' is constructed in 8 parts, each weighing about 7 tons
- ✓ The length of the 'Thridandam' is 162 feet
- ✓ It will be positioned from the feet of the statue hanging onto the shoulder and raising above the head by 27 feet.
- ✓ The 'jalapavithram' will be installed on the top edge of the 'Thridandam' and weighs around 6 tons. 'Jala Pavithram', is a square shaped white colored cloth (signifies the purity of each act done through the hands of a Yathi / Saint) installed at the top edge of the 'Thridandam'

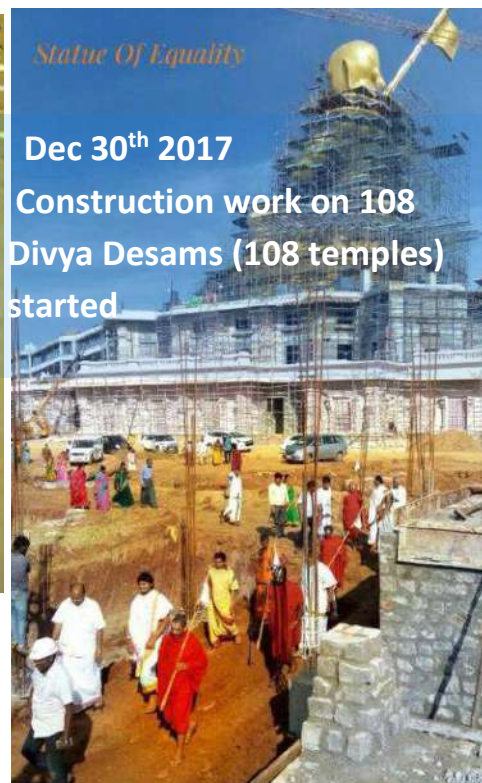

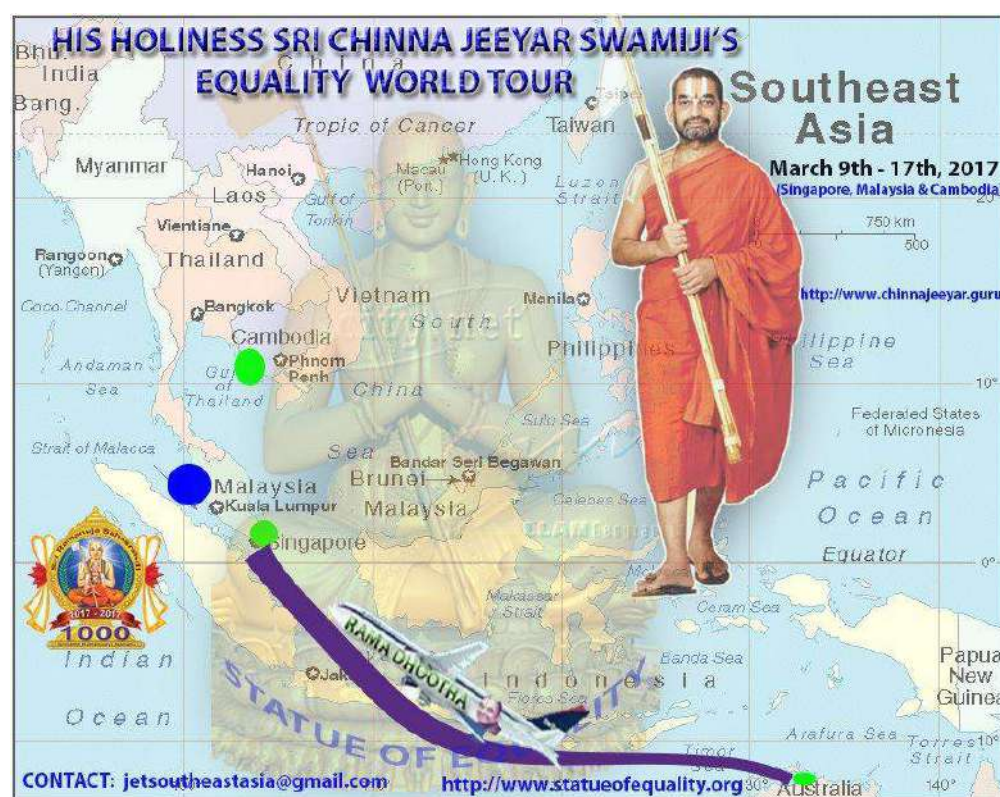

The government of Bharath will be releasing a stamp on 1st May in honor and memory of Saint Ra:ma:nujacharya. “Born in 1903, in the Jyestha star of the Pushya Month, Gopala:charya Swamy became a very close associate of HH Pedda Jeeyar Swamiji who was younger by 6 years. Their friendship was very unique, surprising and astounding. It is impossible not mention about one while talking about the other. They both are like two sides of one coin. They both took up the cause of spreading the fragrance of Ramanuja Sampradaya all over at an early age of 21/27 years.

Gopala:charya Swamy & Pedda Jeeyar Swamiji



Gopala:charya Swamy was an expert in creating a piece, HH Pedda Jeeyar Swamiji was an expert in making sure it reached everyone. Their bondage and collective effort helped in achieving their goal. His life mission was to stand guard for Vedic Philosophy by way of teaching and preparing scholars in Vedantha, Prabandhas, Upanishaths. He taught Vedantha to 8 Thridandi Jeeyars and many more scholars in Bharath. He got disciples in North, South and also from Nepal.

Sriman Gopala:charya's wish was to constantly recollect the qualities of God and he lived his whole life studying scriptures, teaching students continuously and writing innumerable books for the benefit of truth seekers. Sastras say that man has to face successes and difficulties equally. But it's very tough to practice. However Gopala:charya Swamy was a perfect example on how to face both good and bad times equally. He was constantly suffering from asthma, piles, migraine, sarpi etc but they never stopped him from teaching students.

Gopala:charya Swamy's Positive Thinking is another facet which we need to learn. He was a “Jna:na gani” “a mine of knowledge” who spent all his life from his 16th year to 93 years sharing his knowledge with one and all.

It was the effort of Gopala:charya Swamy and Pedda Jeeyar Swamy that women are able to chant Sri Vishnu Sahasranama, Ramayana , Bhagavad Ge:tha and many other scriptures. Strengthening the principle of Bhagavad Ramanujacharya that **“ALL ARE EQUAL BEFORE GOD”**, Pedda Jeeyar Swamiji started a social revolution by building the first colony for Harijans in India in 1930s, conducting sa:muhika Lakshmi pujas by wome and Gopala:charya Swamy opened the door for learning scriptures to women. To implement it, he taught his 8 year old girl the whole Bhagavad Ge:tha with meanings and purport and displayed the effort in front of many great learned pundits in one of the Vedic Sabhas in 1940s.

It was Gopala:charya Swamy and Sri Pedda Jeeyar Swamiji who showed to the world that social service and spirituality are not different but go hand in hand. In fact, one needs to do service on the foundations of sampradaya which is now followed by Vikasa Tarangini.

Time – is the greatest wealth if lost can never be retained. Swamy never wasted even a single second. He always preached his students. He was very good in English. He used to say “Don't waste time. Catch time with the forelocks”. Thus his life became a living example for many to learn and follow.

“Upa:yanam” means gift. Gopalopa:yanam first started with U.Ve. Sri Raghunathacharya Swamy's contribution 19 years ago. It is our duty to glorify our acharyas. Ramanuja. Let us join hands and tell the world about the greatness of Ramanujacharya. Let's convey the information to one and all and invite them to join in this humble offering to our a:charya.” – **Jai Srimannarayana!**
